The Safety Council of Northwest Ohio is once again proud to offer the Annual Bicycle Safety Education Program for your 4th grade students this spring. This has always been a popular program with the children, as well as teachers. Each year, 1,200 + bicyclists are fatally injured and over ½ million bicycle-related injuries are treated in hospital emergency rooms.

The program teaches safe bicycling habits, increased awareness for bike helmets, and rules every cyclist should know. The program will begin on **April 20, 2009 and run through May 22, 2009**. Each session is approximately 45 minutes in length.

To give our instructors more time with the students and less time setting up materials, we request the following (if possible):

- ⬇ Please select an ample sized room, first floor preferred.
- ⬇ A teacher to be present at all times.
- ⬇ A maximum of 50 students is desirable.
- ⬇ If more than one session is required, times must run consecutively.
