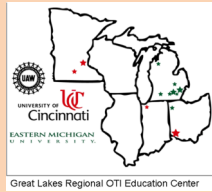

**Breakfast with the Experts– Children's Health – What Laws and Duties Must Employers be Aware Of?**

Health and safety organizations across the world now define children as a life-stage from "conception to adolescence." Regulations are being created and revised to help protect children's health from workplace, environmental, or product exposures including new and upcoming rules from the EPA, CPSC, TSCA, and the Fair Labor Standards Act. An upcoming rule change to OSHA haz-com will require the hazard statement "may damage the unborn child" that will necessitate new training and handling precautions for all chemicals that pose developmental health risk. Negligence and harm to children's health during pregnancy or childhood from work processes, product, or wastes poses huge financial risk.

Presenters will discuss evolving trends and new risk treatment options for this issue that employers may implement as a best management practice.
